We enjoyed Cheshire Homelands so much last year we thought that we would repeat it and hope you will all book and join us for a fantastic Bank Holiday weekend.

We are to be based at Alvaston Hall Hotel just outside Nantwich. The picturesque and historic market town of Nantwich is set deep in the heart of the Cheshire countryside, famous for its black and white buildings, there are many things to visit as well as some excellent roads.

In 1896 Mr. Arthur Knowles, a wealthy Manchester industrialist, bought the Grove and changed it into a grand country house. It was renamed Alvaston Hall and turned into one of the centres of Cheshire social life. Arthur Knowles spent much of his considerable fortune on Alvaston Hall. He built lovely grounds containing a cricket pitch, tennis courts and a great barn like building which housed one of the first electrical systems in England.

He died in 1929 and the Hall and its contents were auctioned off in 1930. After a succession of private owners Alvaston Hall was converted into a Hotel in 1964, it has been extended over the years and now has more than a hundred bedrooms.

The Hotel offers a wide range of leisure facilities:-Heated Indoor Swimming Pool, Spa Pool, Sauna and Steam Room, Gym while outside there are the following facilities - Air rifle shooting, Outdoor bowls, Putting Green, Archery, Croquet and Golf (if you wish to play golf you can hire clubs and will need to book two weeks in advance)



There are also beauty and pamper treatments available (which will have to be booked at least two weeks in advance – brochures available from us on request) On the Sunday if anybody wishes to go shopping/sightseeing in Chester a coach departs the Hotel at 10:00am on Sunday and returns at 3:00pm at a cost of £10.00 per person person.

There will also be a cabaret show on each evening from approximately 9:30pm onwards in the dining room but if that is not your thing there are also two bars as well. This year 's star attraction is Eddison Lighthouse.

We have arranged some excellent ride-outs to suit all tastes and we also have the option of walks from the Hotel into the surrounding Cheshire countryside or alternatively a stroll into Nantwich 15 – 20 minuets walk away for some retail therapy Oulton Park racing circuit is nearby and there is bound to be some event on over the week. end but.

We have booked dinner bed and breakfast and with dinner each evening there is the option of table service or a carvery for the main course.
