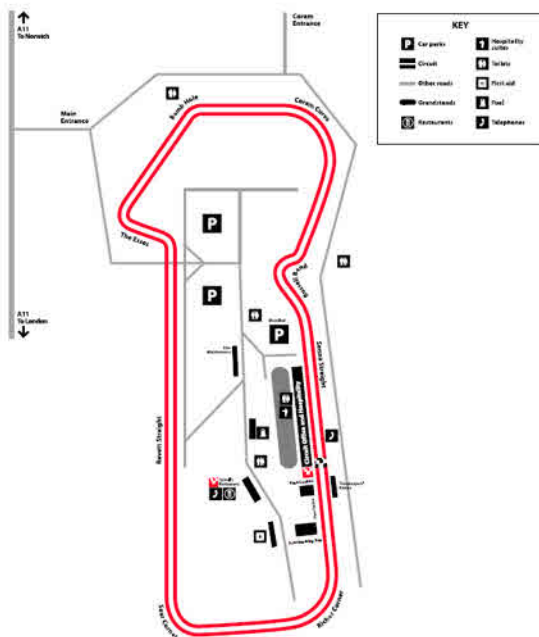


TRACK TRAINING DAY AND TURN UP MONDAY 16TH AUGUST 2010

For this event you have the choice of booking to ride on track or just turning up on the day to socialise and spectate.



The day is being organised by the BMW Owner's Club who cater for the 'more mature' rider. A full briefing is given and the day is good for Novices. Instructors will be on hand to help throughout the day. They will run the day as a training day rather than a track day and they say –

It's not going to be a normal track day, it will be beginner friendly, 3 groups of riders, i.e. Beginners, improvers and experienced.

The beginner group will only have 30 riders, (we are allowed 48) there will be excellent instructors and the aim of the day is to start at your own pace and learn to enjoy gliding through corners smoothly and building up a comfortable pace.

More experienced riders are also welcome but must realise there could be a vast speed difference on the Revett straight. Even the best rider on an airhead boxer could be 30 mph slower than a reasonably ridden K1300S.

Snetterton is an old US Air Force base in Norfolk about ten miles North East of Thetford on the A11. The circuit is

1.95 miles in length and has the long Revett straight.

If you've never tried a track day before this is a good opportunity to improve your biking skills in the company of like-minded people.

If you prefer not to ride on track then just turn up on the day, wander around the paddock, look at the bikes and watch the action. There is no cost for this and the paddock café will be open if you want to buy food and drink.

Cost of the day is £100 for those who wish to ride. Ian has application forms and can email one to those who are interested. Completed forms should be returned to the BMW Owner's Club with payment and not to Ian or Mike Embling.

Early booking is recommended as the day often fills early.
